- 18. **Severability.** If any provision of this Agreement is for any reason found to be unenforceable, all other provisions nonetheless remain enforceable, and the provision found to be unenforceable shall be severable from the other provisions of this contract without affecting the enforceability of the remainder of the document.
- 19. **Fiduciary Duty.** Each Party, upon execution, promises to act in good faith and to deal fairly with the other Party, including in the management of their joint property and/or accounts in acting under the terms of this Agreement.
- 20. Enforceability. With regards to enforceability:
 - A. The Parties agree to provide and execute such further documentation as may be reasonably required to give full force and effect to each term of this Agreement.
 - B. This Agreement binds and inures to the benefit of the Parties and their respective legatees, devisees, heirs, executors, legal and personal representatives, assigns, transferees, and successors in interest.
 - C. This Agreement may be enforced by suit in law or equity by either of the Parties or by their heirs, executors, attorneys, or assigns.
- 21. **Attorney's Fees.** If either Party brings an action or other proceeding to enforce this Agreement or to enforce any judgment or order made by a court in connection with this Agreement, the prevailing Party will be entitled to recover reasonable attorney's fees and other necessary costs from the other Party. If either Party files a declaratory judgment proceeding to determine the enforceability of this Agreement, neither Party will be entitled to an award of attorney's fees unless a Party successfully challenges the validity of this Agreement, in which event the court will have the authority to award attorney's fees. If either Party seeks to invalidate some or all of this Agreement or seeks to recover property in a manner at variance with this Agreement, the successful Party will be entitled to recover reasonable attorney's fees and other necessary costs from the other Party.
- 22. **Headings.**The section headings herein are for references purposes only and shall not otherwise affect the meaning, construction or interpretation of any provision in this Agreement.
- 23. **Incorporation of Exhibits**. All Exhibits to this Agreement are hereby fully incorporated into this Agreement as though fully set forth verbatim.
- 24. **Entire Agreement.** This Agreement, including all Exhibits attached hereto (if any), contains the entire understanding between the Parties and supersedes and cancels all prior agreements of the Parties, whether oral or written, with respect to such subject matter.
